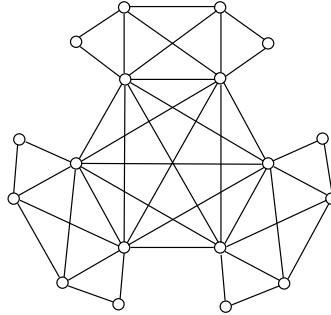


Figure 1: A directed path graph which is not tree 3-spanner admissible
